Land to the South of Blakesley Hill, Greens Norton

The Richborough team have responded to feedback from earlier planning applications and have reduced the size of the site to only the parcel of land directly south of Blakesley Hill. By reducing the size of the development site this also reduces the scale of the proposed development by around a half.

As a result, the new proposals seek planning permission for approximately 69 homes, including 35 affordable homes, enhanced landscaping, public open space, and drainage infrastructure.


The proposals are supported by a range of detailed reports and surveys which have helped to inform the smaller scheme.

The Proposal

The benefits to be delivered by the development include:

- Provision of approximately 69 new market and affordable homes;
- A variety of properties types and sizes, including bungalows, starter homes and family housing, across varying tenures;
- Low density housing around the periphery of the development to help establish an informal rural edge character;
- Provision of well-surveilled public open spaces, including children's play areas, at key strategic locations within the development;
- Protection and enhancement of existing landscape features and biodiversity habitats;
- Opportunities to enhance existing community facilities and local infrastructure, including contributions to increase the frequency of the existing bus service to Northampton and Towcester; and
- A high quality development in a landscaped setting.
